New York Theater credits include stints with the Public Theater/ New York Shakespeare Festival, New Federal Theater, Target Margin, Circle Rep Company, HERE, Prospect Theater Company, The Hotel Savant, Ensemble Studio Theater East, and The Lark Play Development Center. Los Angeles Theater includes time with Sacred Fools, Company of Angels, City Garage, and Independent Shakespeare Company. Film and TV credits include roles on "Law and Order", "As the World Turns", "Another World", "New York News", "Bandwagon", "Fiveflies", and "The Heartland Series." Rafeal has taught acting, scene study, voice, and speech on the high-school level and in acting schools. He currently has spent the past 15 years working with a public charity that provides healthcare to low-income communities in Los Angeles. Rafeal is a graduate of the University of Tennessee and Yale School of Drama.

ARABELLA FIELD is a Theatre World Award winning actor, and a writer. She has performed in theatres in New York, Los Angeles, and across the country.
